

- Māori and Pasifika students who are Below and Well Below the expected Curriculum level in Mathematics/Pāngarau will be provided with extra support to accelerate their progress towards the expected Curriculum level by year-end.

HUARAHI MĀORI BILINGUAL PATHWAYS

To continue to provide a Bilingual Pathway in Te Reo Māori within a tikanga and te ao Māori context

- Increased normalisation of te reo Māori throughout the wider school, with every student having access to quality language that's relevant to their own context within the school and at home
- Acceleration in progress for our students who are below the expected curriculum level in Tuhituhi
- Embed the collaborative pedagogical practices currently utilised throughout the school and align them
- to the specific context of Te Rumaki Reo o Te Waitītiko
- Enrichment and Extension programmes are in place to support language learners
